He is a pioneer in defensive cyberspace operations having previously established and led the U.S. Air Force's first enterprise-scoped counter-cyber operations capability. In this role, he led a team of 28 operators tasked with finding, tracking, and neutralizing state-sponsored threats on the Air Force's \$2B, 800k node network. He personally conducted or oversaw 350+ adversarial hunt and rapid response missions on networks throughout the world.
